
Cutlass Bearing Removal



Cutlass Bearing Removal

The following procedure does not require removal of the propeller shaft in order to change the bearing!

- 1. Remove propeller.
- 2. Undo grub screws.
- 3. Make a wire hook.
- 4. Slide the hook between the shaft and bearing catching hold of the inner end of the bearing. With a little persuasion the bearing can now be drawn out.
- 5. Slide the new bearing into the housing. Fasten with grub screws.
- 6. Refit propeller.

If the bearing cannot be persuaded to loosen in the above manner the complete bearing housing must be removed.

- 1. Clean/chisel away filler and paint and remove the M10 bolts or bolt holding the bearing housing flange to the hull.
- 2. Using a large pipe wrench unscrew (anticlockwise) the bearing housing.
- 3. Use a piece of pipe or similar to drive out the old bearing from the housing.
- 4. Refit bearing. Fasten with grub screws.
- 5. Screw the housing back into place use a mastic sealant on all joints and bolts.
- 6. Finish and paint.
- 7. Refit propeller.
